- Previously, customers in Overlay and Metro-Extended Local NPA area could not complete both 7 and 10-digit calls. Both 7 and 10 digit calls will now complete in this scenario.
- Previously, When a customer experienced a reset sys 4 or power outage, processor channels did not come back up. The processor channels will now come up in a functioning mode after a reset system 4 or power outage.
- Previously, the Emergency Attendant Access feature could tie up the attendant console. This is no longer the case.
