1. INTRODUCTION

The MusicTel-60 is a digital music-on-hold player. It is built with absolutely no mechanically moving parts. MusicTel-60 allows 60 seconds of stored music in a non-volatile memory. Recording is performed by connecting the MusicTel-60 to an external audio device.

The MusicTel-60 has the following features:

- High quality recording.
- 60 seconds of recording time.
- Non-volatile memory.
- Built-in speaker monitor and test button.
- Simple operation and maintenance.

2. DESCRIPTION

2.1 Physical Description

The functional components of the MusicTel-60 are located on its front panel. The LEDs and buttons are located on the top panel.




Figure 2-1. MusicTel-60 Top Panel




Figure 2-2. MusicTel-60 Front Panel

2.2 Unpacking

The package includes the following components:

- 1. MusicTel-60.
- 2. Power adapter.
- 3. Audio cable (Standard RJ-11 cable).
- 4. Recording cable.
- 5. Packet, containing 2 screws and 2 wall plugs.

If any of these components are damaged or missing, please contact your local Aleen Technologies dealer.

3. INSTALLATION

The MusicTel-60 is delivered with pre-recorded music. New music can be recorded before mounting the MusicTel-60 on the wall and before connecting it to the PBX. If no new music is to be recorded, proceed with installation as described in Paragraph 3.2.

3.1 Recording Instructions

To record music on the MusicTel-60, a special Recording cable must be used (provided). Record new music on the MusicTel-60 by following these instructions:

- 1. Plug the 9VDC adapter jack into the MusicTel-60 power supply connector. Next, connect the 9VDC adapter to the mains power supply.
- Connect the Recording cable (enclosed in the packaging) to the RJ-11 socket on the front panel of the MusicTel-60 (see Figure 2-2).




Figure 3-1. Connecting the Recording Cable

 Next, connect the Recording cable to the music source device (CD player, tape etc.), as described in Figure 3-1 below.

- 3. To start recording, press the Play button on the CD player, and the button of the MusicTel-60, simultaneously. The recorded music will be heard through the speaker of the MusicTel-60.
- 4. To stop the recording, press the recording button again.
- 5. Test the recording by pressing the test button on the MusicTel-60.
- 6. Disconnect the Recording cable from the music source device and the MusicTel-60.

3.2 Physical Installation

Install the MusicTel-60 according to the following steps:

- Use a drill and the wall plugs to place the two screws, and mount the MusicTel-60 close to the PBX.




Figure 3-2. Connecting the Audio Cable

- Connect the Audio cable to the MusicTel-60 and to the MOH (Music On Hold) jack in the PBX, as described in Figure 3-2 below.

Note:

The Music-Tel 60 should be connected to a special MOH input on the PBX only.

3.3 MOH Playback Level

MOH (Music On Hold) playback level must be tested to ensure it is recorded at adequate levels.

To test MOH volume levels:

- 1. Call the PBX from an external line.
- 2. Put the call on 'Hold'. The MOH should now be heard.
- 3. Adjust the MOH audio levels by adjusting the volume level potentiometer, located on the front panel of the MusicTel-60 (see Figure 2-2).
- 4. End the call.

4. SPECIFICATIONS

4.1 Recording Cable

RJ-11 pins 1,2 – Audio In.

Connected to the P.L. plug, which connects to the music source device (CD player etc).

RJ-11 pin 5,6 – Short-Circuited.




Figure 4-1. Recording Cable

The short-circuit is applied at the P.L. end of the recording cable (see Figure 4-1).

4.2 Audio Cable

RJ-11 (MusicTel-60) pin 3,4 – Audio Out.

The audio cable is connected to the MusicTel-60 and to the MOH (Music On Hold) jack in the PBX.




Figure 4-2. Audio Cable
