This layout is designed for two-sided printing. Or else you could paste two, single-sided printouts back-to-back with a glue stick. Trim to a folded size of $3\frac{1}{2}$ " by $5\frac{1}{2}$." If printing from Acrobat, specify "none" for page scaling in the print dialog window.
