





nstallation


1. Peel the protective covering off of the name directory as shown below.




2. Peel the protective covering off of BOTH sides of the lexan plastic window as shown below.




3. Slide the name card (not included) into the slots on each side of the black plastic back as shown below.




4. Place the clear plastic window into the back of the name directory. Then place the black plastic back with the names showing through plastic window, into the back of the name directory as shown below.



6. Making sure to align all holes, use (2) # 10 Torx head screws (included) to mount the name directory to the surface as shown below.
