PART 1

AN INTRODUCTION TO THE ETS-106

The Electronic Telephone System (ETS) is a sophisticated, computer-controlled communications system designed to match your busy lifestyle, whether it is used in your home or in your business. Compact, efficient, easy to install and easy to use, the ETS-106 will enhance the way you communicate to those in your home or business, as well as the outside world.

Each telephone in your new system lets you locate anyone in your home or business with the touch of an intercom button, transfer calls or put them on Hold, establish conference calls, or put a particular telephone in a Do Not Disturb mode.

First, however, you must learn about the installation of your system, and the installation of several pieces of optional equipment (including a Monitor Box, an Energy Control System, and an Automatic Door Unlock System) which you may have purchased.

We will begin the discussion with a series of brief descriptions of each piece of ETS-106 equipment.

NOTE: Please read through this entire manual *at least once* before ordering any additional equipment or attempting any installation.
